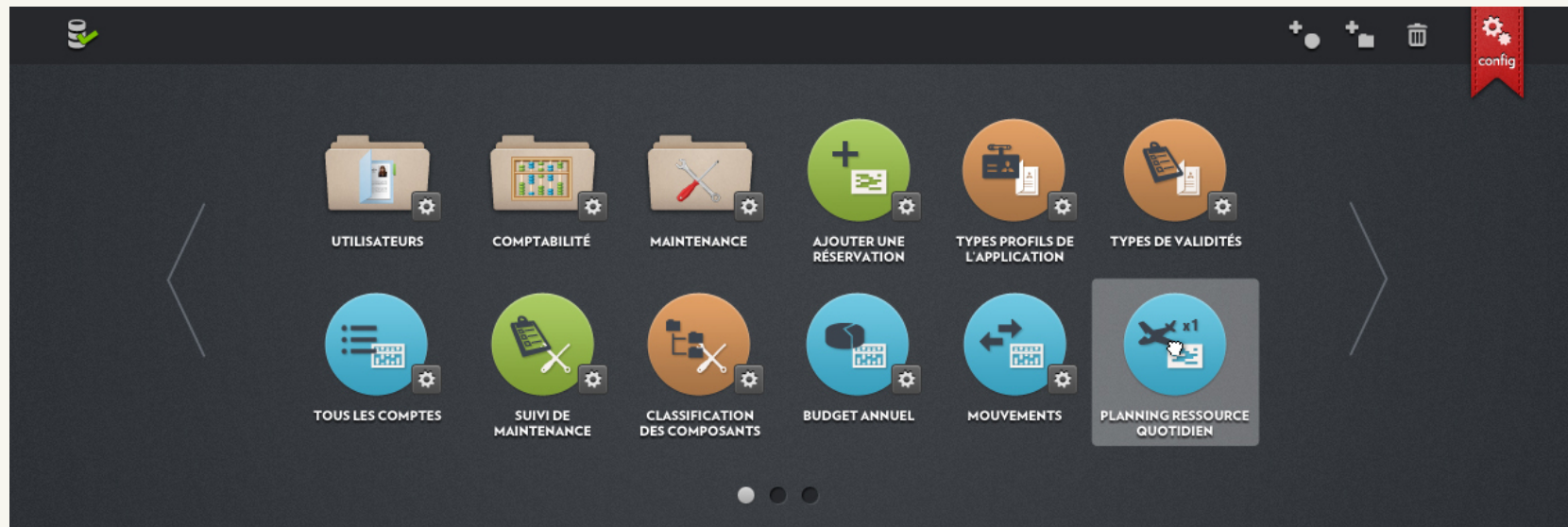
OpenFlyers 3.0.3 stable and upcoming release of OpenFlyers 4.0



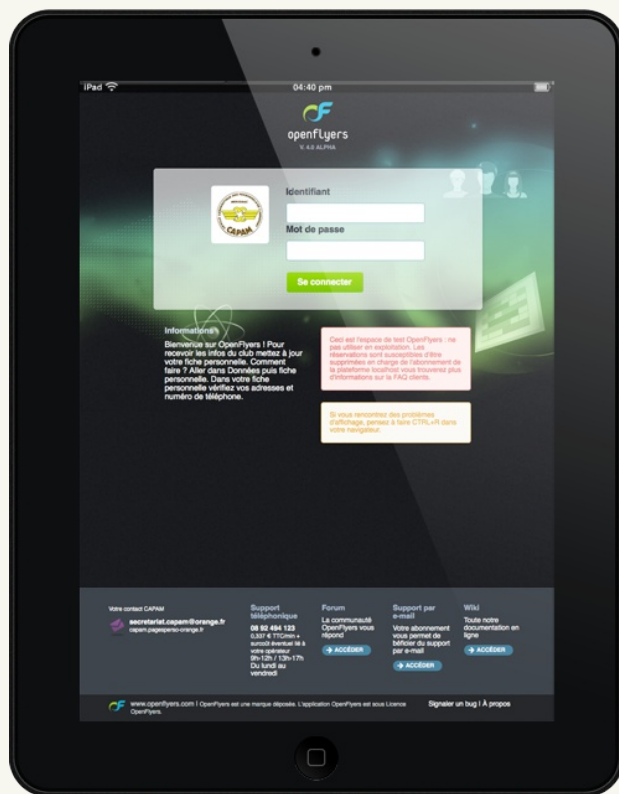
OpenFlyers 4.0

UI (*User Interface*) layouts were created a few months ago. We are now building template pages corresponding to the layouts and redeveloping version 3 with specifications of version 4. Thus, version 4.0 will be available soon for our beta-testers customers.

The main aim of version 4.0 is to build a **tactile-ready user interface** with richer ergonomics and better interactivity.

In the meantime, version 3.0 jumped forward, and **became stable** in February with version 3.0.2 then 3.0.3.

From now on, we only propose latest version 3.0.3 to our new customers when creating their account.

Consequences on development request

We have stopped developments under version 3.0 and do not edit cost estimates for development purposes anymore. Features requested will be published under version 4.0.

Development news

Internet Explorer 7

We do not maintain compatibility with Internet Explorer 7.

Information :

- We advise to use Mozilla Firefox or Google Chrome browsers in Windows environments.
- We have not maintain Internet Explorer 6 compatibility since July 2011.
- Internet Explorer latest version is version 10.

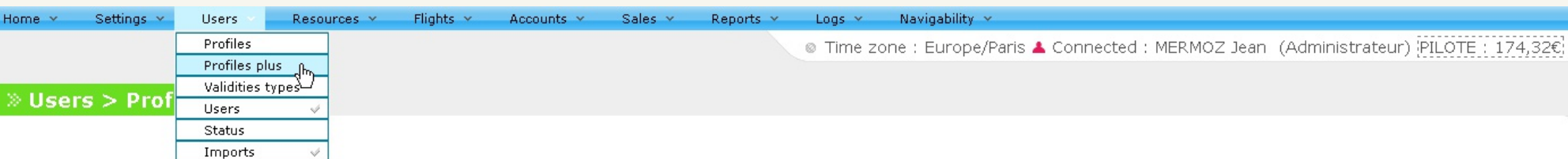
Suppression of *groups* and addition of the *profile plus* menu

With OpenFlyers version 3.0.3 :

- The *user groups* conception is abandoned to be integrated in the *profile* conception. **Groups do not determine pricing parameters anymore ; profiles do it now.** This simplifies user management by deleting an *abstract layer* in conceptualization.
- *Member* and *instructor* user categories are deprecated. From now on, **an instructor is equivalent to a profile** which can access *personal planning* and *personal planning visible for the others*. *Member* conception is abandoned too. So does the *subscription field* which was related to it on user sheets. The *subscription* field is replaced by the *subscription validity*.

- A new menu has been built : **profile plus**. It conveys the ability to add *profile specifications* which were formerly distinct from *privileges*. Thus, in this new table, you can find the following columns :

- **Required account type** : lets you define account types which must be created for every user, according to his profile. In particular, one can use this to manage financial flows with work councils which limitate cost contributions.
- **Visible extra-field by the profile** : lets you define how custom fields are visible in *user*, *booking* and *flight hours* forms. This ensures the protection of confidential datas.
- **Addable validity type** : lets you define the *validity area* in which you can add validities.
- **Place assignment** : lets you define which place a user can occupy. In this column, you can use configuration tools to re-create the deprecated *instructor notion* (cf. above).
- **Visible profiles** : lets you define which profiles are visible depending on users (using the *individual planning visible for others*). This feature can especially be useful for charities or firms managing independant activities (in terms of localizations or professions).
- **Visible ressource types** : lets you restrain the visibility of resources depending on users. Usage examples are the same as above, for *visible profiles*.
